I can't send a donation, but a wanted to thank you for your ministry the past year.....

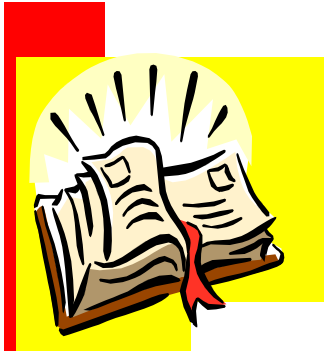

## *Expressions of Love*

In the days ahead we will likely hear clever ads and jingles played on the radio and television. We will have cuddly teddies tug at our heartstrings as we pass by store displays. Cupid will likely dominate decor for a good month or so. In case you forget when it is, the greeting card displays remind us: **Valentines Day is February 14th.**

On that day and in the days prior to it, the retail industry will cash in on one basic human need: the expression of love. It is said that every human needs to be loved and needs to have someone to love. What experts fail to mention is why. Studies have been done on this. Research has been gathered and data analyzed, but as far as I can tell the reason WHY we need to love and to be loved hasn't been explained.

God, the creator and sustainer of the world in which we lived created us with a need. A deep need for love. He created us that way because He wanted to be the only One who would be able to fill that need entirely. God's love is perfect and unconditional. That love is *jealous* for our attention. God's love cannot be manufactured, conjured or substituted for with anything else. Only His deep love will meet our deep need.

How could God show us, a sinful people, the love He has for us without compromising His holiness? What could God possibly turn to for an expression of His deep love?

There was only one answer and it is still the answer today: His Son, Jesus. The Bible tells us Jesus is the express image of God the Father. Jesus expressed the Father's love by choosing to leave His throne in Heaven and enter our world as a pauper. Born in a manger, raised in the ghetto of its age, Jesus walked and talked with crowds, constantly expressing the Father's love. As generations of religious rhetoric alienated the common people, Jesus chose to be the bridge between, and revealed the Father's heart.

When He encountered the sick and outcasts, He did not hesitate to heal. When the people misunderstood this most gracious, purest expression of love and called it blasphemy, He was *silent*. Rather than rally for defense or provoke his followers to revolt. He simply said, "This is what I came to do and I do it willingly for you."

His love ran blood red from His hands, feet and side. And when it was over He also destroyed the work of Love's ultimate enemy: death. He tasted death's sting that we might never have to. He was banished from the presence of His Father as He wore our guilt and shame (though He never sinned) so that we might never have to know that kind of pain.

Love came down from Heaven, in the form of God's own Son. The Bible records it, changed lives testify to His power.

And you and I? *We're here to love others and point people to the ultimate expression of love, our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.*

# How to Please God

One of the ways we know that we are truly saved is that we want to please God, Would you like to know how you can please Him? Here are some ways:

\* We please God when we love Him., Above all else, God wants us to love Him with all our heart. On one occasion a man asked Jesus what was the greatest of all commandments. Jesus replied, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind" (*Matthew 22:37*),

\* We please God when we love His Son. God loves every person, but He has a special love for those who love His Son. Jesus said, "For the Father Himself loves you, because you have loved Me, and have believed that I came out from. God" (*John 16:27*).

\* We please God when we obey **Hint**. The Bible says, "This is the love of God, that we keep His command-ments" (*1 John 5:3*).

\* We please God when we trust Him. The Bible says that God takes pleasure in those who trust Him—those who expect Him to be loving and kind. (*See Psalms 147:11*.)

\* We please God when we thank **Hint**. The Bible says, "In everything give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you" (*1 Thessalonians 5:18*).

\* We please God when we study His Word pray to Him. God speaks to us through His Word. He is pleased when we take time to read His Word and pray to Him. (*See John 15:7*.)

\* We please God when we let Christ live His life In us. Jesus died for us to put away all our sins. Now He lives in us so we can live in a way that is pleasing to God, The apostle Paul said, "For to me to live is Christ [His life in me], and to die is gain" (*Philippians 1:21*).

Christ lives in every believer. Every believer can say, "Christ lives in me!" Say it to yourself right now, "Christ lives in Me!"

I have a new privilege— to let Christ live out His life through me. This is what the Lord Jesus wants to do in every believer. Paul wrote, "I have been crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ lives in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith [the faithfulness] of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave Himself for me" (*Galatians 2:20*).

I have a new purpose in **life**. My purpose now is to please the Lord Jesus Christ. He is God and He lives in me. My goal in life is to please Him in all that I do. Paul's prayer for believers was this: "That you might walk worthy, of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God" (*Colossians 1:10*).
